Our mutual friend Jones Harris kindly provided me with your address so that I might obtain a subscription to your newspaper and also a copy of the November 11, 1965 issue containing the story about Wanda Joyce Killam and John Carter, which I am very anxious to see. Like Jones Harris, I have been sceptical about the conclusions in the Warren Report from the beginning. I am writing a comparative analysis of the discrepancies between the statements in the Report and the material found in the testimony and documents--which are numerous and in most cases serious. I have already completed a subject index, as well as a name index covering the Exhibits, which will be published early next year by Scarecrow Press. Last week I participated in a radio panel discussion, with Sylvan Fox and others, in which we spent some five hours reviewing some of the defects of the investigation and the reasons for questioning the official conclusions.

I have the impression that you have been doing extremely valuable inquiries, in which I feel the greatest interest, and I look forward very much to seeing the November 11th issue and future issues of your newspaper.
