Washington, N.Y.), today introduced in the House of Representatives a Concurrent Resolution to establish a Joint Committee to Determine the recessity of a Congressional Investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy. If the Joint Committee finds, after reviewing all the papers, documents and reports, including, but not limited to the Warren Report, that further investigation is necessary, that Committee would proceed to investigate fully all the facts and circumstances relating to the assassination of President Kennedy and the subsequent killing of his alleged assassin.

The New York City Congressman also called for immediate declassification of all the papers, documents, and reports relating to the Kennedy Assassination and deposited with the National Archives.
