Please accept my thanks and congratulations for your proposal calling for a Congressional inquiry into the adequacy of the Warren Report.

My "Notes for a New Investigation" will be published in Esquire December 1966 issue (available mid-November), presenting a sampling of inquiries and scientific tests which should have been undertaken but were not carried out by the Warren Commission, and which can still be attempted.
