Thank you for your letter of June 21 and the galley copy of "Accessories after the Fact."

I plan to go through it over the 4th of July weekend. In the meantime, I have just leafed through the pages and find that at the insert for galley, page 73, footnote 48, line 8, the word "forensic" is misspelled.

My last page is 168A, but there obviously is more which I do not have.

In the acknowledgement, second paragraph, the word "and" is left out at the end.

I am thinking of saying something to the following effect about the book:

When I first became interested in the Warren Commission Report and its obvious failures, I was perturbed that I too might do a poor job with reference to the known facts. There was no index to the Report or to the 26 volumes of hearings and exhibits. Then I met Sylvia Maghar. This girl, on this subject, could take the place of a computer-- instead of pushing a button you called Sylvia and you got your answer with cross-references as to what was available in these volumes, or as to what had been written in the field.

Whether you agree with her thesis or not, you do know that she has researched the question and can find the citation in an instant. This goes a long way toward establishing her credibility.
