My further survey (following up on my letter of June 26) of Sylvia Meagher's book is completed.

I have the following points on the galleys:

Page 6 middle * type word should be "motorcade", r is missing.

Page 9A middle - I think the reference to Congressman Ford (a friend of mine) is unfair. The words "to the taxpayer who paid the bill" at the very least goes too far.

Page 9A footnote 13- Does this fit the text?

Page 16A footnote 7 - doesn't tell you anything.

Page 18A - Insert should be footnote 14 not 13.

Page 19A near bottom - Are you sure this is an original sound track and not a dub?

Page 19A bottom * something is missing.

Page 21A top- something is missing before the transcript.

Page 21A - You have several transcript passages together without sufficient indication. Put a line like this between them.

Page 24 - Third paragraph from bottom - typo- "evaluation".

Page 30 middle-Jenner- typo-"if" not "is".

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Page 40A - typo after footnote 7 "face" not "case"

Page 93 - below middle typo- Gopadze (Secret Service interpreter).

Page 110A - Make clear the difference between Congressmen Ford and Mrs. Katherine Ford.

Page 123-type- near bottom "detailed".

Page 168A - Why not go further into the restrictions on the x-rays and photos and the fact that Burke Marshall replies as he does etc. See my statement in Congressional Record of April 13, 1967, at page 84113 et seq.

When is publication? Will Sylvia say something about the four hour GBS show?
