Dear Miss Meagher:

I was sorry I could not see you again, neither give you a ring before our departure from N.Y. but our shooting schedule was too tight - and it was impossible to do anything else. I wish I had been able to converse longer with you, for of all the people I have met who are concerned with the Kennedy affair, you struck me as being the most lucid and the most serious (with Penn Jones).

Now I'm back in Paris where this thing creates a lot of interest, mostly on account of the coming anniversary. Epstein's and Lane's books are going to be published in a few days. A French TV crew is flying over to both Dallas and New York to make a program about it all (and I'm afraid they've scooped me, for I cannot go back there right after the shooting of U-Thant) and the dailies are full of stories about the November issue of "Ramparts". By the way, if you could send one copy to me, I would appreciate it very, very much indeed.

If Penn is with you in N.Y., please give him my best. I hope to be back in N.Y. soon enough and spend more time talking with you.

Again, may I tell you how happy I was to meet you. If there is anything I can do for you in any matter here, be sure and let me know,
