I've been studying it and ,although I believe some of the deaths (Kilgallen, Ruark, and even Tom Howard) have nothing to do with the Dallas business, others are quite mysterious, quite unnerving.

I am thinking - and even laying ground for it - of a book, or a TV Special - or both - on the matter. It may take time to start the project, but once it starts rolling, I'll need your advice. Anyway, by then , I'll be in New York. So, I hope to see you sometime this year or early in 67 - and if, in the meantime, you have anything new on the matter, don't hesitate to write.
