Dear Mr. Lane,

I have learned that a letter dated 30 June 1965 which I addressed to Mr. Stewart Galanor at the post office box maintained by the Citizens' Committee of Inquiry was discarded as "not important" without being shown to Mr. Galanor, but that the enclosure—a photocopy of a letter received by me from the Western Cartridge Company—has been appropriated by the Committee or its staff.

Please be advised that I sent the photocopy letter to Mr. Galanor personally and did not intend it for the use of any other individual or any corporate body. If the photocopy letter is used by you or by the Committee in any form whatever without my authorization, I shall institute legal proceedings at once.

I shall not express an opinion about the disposition which has been made of my letter of 30 June 1965 since persons who were capable of such an outrageous violation of my rights, and those of the addressee, no doubt will be impervious to any protest.

A copy of this letter is going forward to my attorney.
