"Rush to Judgment," by Mark Lande, a New York City lawyer, published by Holt, Rinehart & Winston, is presented as "a critique of the Warren Commission's inquiry into the murders of President John F. Kennedy, Officer J. D. Tippit, and Lee Harvey Oswald."

It is an exhaustive presentation of attorney Lane's case that in the Warren Report, the "evidence against him (accused assassin Oswald) was magnified, while the evidence in his favor was depreciated, misrepresented or ignored."

Lane wrote an article saying that the Dallas district attorney's evidence, as published, contained "inexplicable contradictions." In December, he got a call from Marguerite Oswald, mother of the dead suspect, saying she had read the article and asking him to represent her son before the commission.
