Dear Sirs,

The Council on Library Resources and the H. W. Wilson Company have both been kind enough to suggest that I should contact your Press.

I have compiled a comprehensive subject index to the Warren Report and twenty-six volumes of Hearings and Exhibits which I am convinced is a serious need for the historian and researcher. As you know, the President's Commission on the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy has provided a massive body of data for the scholar, but it is largely unorganized. Undeniably, the value of these reference works is greatly impaired by the lack of a tool such as a subject index by which the student is enabled to identify all relevant material on any single aspect of the investigation without loss of time, frustration, and uncertainty.

I take the liberty of enclosing, in confidence and with a view to possible mutual arrangements, an outline of my subject index, for which I am seeking publication. The index incorporates but extends substantially beyond the footnote citations which appear in the Warren Report for certain subjects; other subjects included in the index are not treated specifically in the Report.

Should you find it possible to consider publication of the index, I will be pleased to provide further information.
