Dear Miss Meagher:

I have your letter of September 11th concerning your index to the Warren Commission Report. Although I have no doubt that the work should be a most useful one in several professional fields, I am sorry to say that in the years since World War II we have ceased to publish specialized indexes and bibliographies; we now confine our work in this field to such serial publications as the Cumulative Book Index and the Bibliographic Index and a few separate publications used in school guidance work.

The following publishers might well be interested in handling your index: the R. R. Bowker Company (1180 Avenue of the Americas, New York, New York 10036), which publishes a variety of reference books for the library market; the Shoe String Press (60 Connolly Parkway, Hamden, Connecticut 06514), which publishes a somewhat larger number of books for the library market, generally in smaller editions than Bowker's; and the Thomas Y. Crowell Company (201 Park Avenue, South, New York, New York 10003), a trade publishing firm with a strong reference department.

I believe it would be worth your while to offer your index to these publishers. I am only sorry that we cannot express interest in it ourselves.
