I thank you for your letter of 25 June 1965 but I am sorry to say that it does not really assist me. I have already made a careful study of the Hearings and Exhibits of the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy without discovering any information which might clarify the questions in my letter of 15 June to the Chief Justice. I ventured to address him only because it appears that the information I seek is not included in the Commission's files but is known to him personally. Naturally I should be reluctant to make a trip to Washington and search the Archives unless the information is definitely included in the material available to members of the public.

May I hope that you will be good enough to provide me with further guidance?
