I have your letter of December 6th concerning the story headlined, "There Was a Second Shooter Behind the Wall."

As you know, the Warren Commission not only published a large one-volume Report but also published 26 volumes of hearings. As a Commission we went into the matter as thoroughly as it is humanly possible to do and did not depend entirely on testimony received from other government agencies.

We examined all the rumors, charges and counter-charges. I am convinced that the conclusions reached by the Commission and published in the report are sound and accurate.

I, too, have seen and heard various rumors, charges and counter-charges subsequent to the issuance of the report. However, nothing has developed which would alter my view as to the conclusions reached in the Warren report.
