With the enclosures sent now, plus those sent yesterday, I have now supplied 125 pages out of the 139 pages you requested. Of the still unfilled request. 6 pages are already in your possession as indicated above. Therefore, only 8 of the 139 pages remain lost-strayed-or-stolen, and I suggest that it will be more economical to include them in your abnp microfilm order than to invest the time and labor required to search further, with no assurance of success.
