
Dear Mrs. Meagher,

I just wanted to write you so that we don't get out of touch. In case you haven't heard yet, we now do have a Committee in New York under the direction of Trent Gough who worked a little for the old Committee. If you would like, I'll ask him to get in touch with you, but I fully realize that you are very busy and do not wish to be involved in other areas besides research.
