I wish to make a correction of fact in my letter to you of July 13, 1967.

On page two, in paragraph three, I stated, "Ruins testified to the Warren Commission that the man was a negro." This is incorrect. On November 22, 1963, Amos Ruins (then 15-years-old) told a news reporter that he had seen a colored man with a rifle lean out of an upstairs window of the building. Before the Warren Commission, he stated that he did not know whether the man was white or negro.

As I'm certain you realize, this error in no way alters the substance of my letter.
