Dear Sir,

This will acknowledge receipt of your special delivery letter dated 29 January 1968, addressed to "Mr. Garrison and Others."

I would be delighted and unhesitating to pledge my complete support to any responsible effort to compel retraction of an infamous and fraudulent version of the assassination of President Kennedy, whether that version originates with the Warren Commission or the New Orleans District Attorney. I would be especially ready to join any effort to expose both so-called "investigations," which have in common such practices as deliberate misrepresentation of fact, perversion of evidence, and eagerness to vilify Lee Harvey Oswald as an assassin on the most flimsy and grotesque grounds.

As for joining any effort requiring "solidarity" with Mr. Garrison or the generation of pressure on his behalf, I am more likely to take up parachute jumping or to nominate General Ky for the Peace Prize. It happens, gentlemen, that I am irrevocably opposed to all travesties of justice and all falsified versions of the events of Dallas, including those authored by the New Orleans District Attorney no less than those of the Warren Commission.

For these reasons, I must decline to be associated with your activities.
