A. Jim Garrison and his investigation in New Orleans.

My personal knowledge of his case is slight in that I only know what I have read, but I have felt that he at least deserves his day in court and in that sense I feel that he should have support. I am interested in the reasons behind your feeling the way that you do. If it would not compromise some information of your own, would you tell me why you feel the way you do?

I am presently reading your latest book, "Accessories After the Fact", and am delighted with it and feel obligated to you for it.

In following up some of your citations I am confused about a couple of things at this stage. What are "The Reporter" and "The Minority of One?" I would like to send for copies of them.

Has anyone contacted Stanley Kaufman in regard to finding out the names of the jail inmates who saw the assassination and getting their information?
