Former Congressman Al-
lard Lowenstein was in Los
Angeles last week making
speeches and following up
leads to the effect that Bobby
Kennedy's assassination in
1968 was not the open-and-
shut case it appeared. When
I reached Lowenstein by

phone, he said, "I am con-
cerned about the official ver-
sion and I'm checking it."
He would not discuss the
matter further. Recently Low-
enstein told New York friends
he had second-hand informa-
tion that Sirhan Sirhan, con-
victed of the assassination
may not have been the actual
killer, or that he had not
worked alone.
