Ousted F.B.I. Man's Plea Is Refused by High Court

WASHINGTON, Nov. 9 (AP)

The Supreme Court refused today to rule on a complaint by an agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that he was improperly dismissed for writing letters to Congressmen that, the bureau said, contained untrue statements.

The agent, William W. Turner, was dismissed in July, 1961, in a dispute over his assignment to duty at Oklahoma City.
