TIP FROM FBI

Ray Search Turns To Australia

CANBERRA, Australia (AP)—Australian police are mak-
ing a nationwide search for James Earl Ray, wanted in the
United States on a charge of killing Dr. Martin Luther King
Jr.

Police officials said the U.S. Federal Bureau of Investiga-
tion cabled that it had infor-
mation indicating Ray, also
known as Eric Starvo Galt,
might have fled to Australia.

Australian police have also
begun an intensive examina-
tion of all entry documents
filed at points of entry since
King's assassination, but offi-
cers say nothing positive has
turned up yet.

The Australian embassy in
Washington said it was mak-
ing a routine check to deter-
mine whether an application
for an entry permit to Aus-
tralia had been filed by Ray.
An embassy official said it
acted at the request of the
FBI.
