The New Leader of Nov. 22 and Dec. 20 has two articles which will be followed by another written by Leo Souvage. The articles are very well done and repudiate the Warren Commission findings.

Although I have not contacted Stamm, I will do so. Liberation has not replied to my letters and calls about Lillian's material. I don't know quite what to make of it, except that the material is being reviewed by a literary critic who is going to make up Liberation's mind for them.

Tell Lillian to be a little more patient. I will keep pressing for a response.
