Dear Mr. Wyckoff:

I am in receipt of a letter dated July 19 from Mr. Leo Kelley of your firm, which he said was in response to my letter to you of July 12.

I can understand that after a TV appearance such as yours, it is to be expected that you would receive a considerable amount of mail. I have little doubt, however, that you are fully competent to discern, from the content of a letter, whether or not its author has engaged in serious work with the Zapruder film. In my own case, I trust you will not deem it immodest if I point out that our personal meeting in your office gave you ample opportunity to observe that my work in this area has been serious.


I believe the situation is as follows:

1. You voluntarily undertook a study of the Zapruder film for CBS.
2. You presented some of your findings in person on the CBS program.
3. CBS relied heavily on your findings in drawing its major conclusions.
4. The CBS Warren Report program has now become part of the record of this momentous and controversial event in our nation's history.
5. On the basis of my own lengthy study of the Zapruder film, I have reason to doubt that the three-shot conclusion you apparently drew -- ostensibly based on blurs in the film -- is tenable.
6. My letter to you of July 12 contained inquiries designed to elicit clarification from you regarding serious questions as to your study and findings. Therefore, it, too, now becomes part of the record of this case -- as do your responses, or lack thereof.
7. The accuracy of that record will be served by your answers to my inquiries.

Further, I must point out that, since it was you and not Mr. Kelly who appeared on the CBS program; and since it was your conclusions and not Mr. Kelly's upon which CBS relied; it follows that only you can adequately answer the questions I have raised. Therefore, while I am sending a copy of this letter to him, I respectfully request that the reply come from you.
