In my own mind, I do feel a 237-38 ^{hit} is proven beyond reasonable doubt. I feel certain my observations are correct -- the turn was halted momentarily at 238; and his shoulder was suddenly depressed, indicating unmistakably that its direction has been reversed.

I also feel certain that he has been hit by 238. As to when the hit actually occurred, I am almost certain the depressed shoulder is the instantaneous result of motion imparted by an impact; and not ~~the~~ delayed reaction resulting from a hit ^{visibly} prior to 237, ~~hit~~ -- but I would like to know what expert opinion would be on that score.
