My Methodist postmaster had a low opinion of Catholics already! Penn said something about being on the Mort Sol show. Will you get to see it or hear it?

I wish I felt as optimistic as you aboyt the X-rays and films. Did you hear LBJ's press conferece remarks in this regard? Either he is playing dumb or
 He remarked that pictures of the bloody clothing witan witherd-but of course they were not, but have been in the books all along.
