Thanks for your card about the Elsbeth Street address. You understandably explain the circumstances as described in highly compressed form in the Esquire article. But those few lines are boiled down from four pages of my manuscript, which outlines somewhat more complicated circumstances which would not be explained away so easily. For example, the use of the Elsbeth St. address on a list compiled at the Depository, where supposedly they knew only his Irving address--compiled by two police officers before they had any known access to material in Oswald's wallet. Two more officers are involved who used the address at the police station--the Commission asked Revill to obtain an explanation and he promised to submit one, but there the printed record ends.

Much excitement since Life came out. The developments are coming thick and fast, I can't keep up. How do things look to you?
