Would you really want me any other way? If the price of friendship with the Left is slavish love and obedience then I want no part of it. I am my own person and I always will be. Although you and I have argued over the Kennedys, I can't remember ever telling you that you had no right to disagree with them. Arnoni is "abusive" of the Kennedys every time he speaks, yet when I criticize him for this I am accused of being abusive to him, which I am told I must not do because "we owe him too much."

I lost my family in a concentration camp too. I also suffered a great deal during the war years, my home was burned to the ground. So I have great sympathy for Mr. Arnoni, but will not give up my free will or my free opinions on that count, just as I do not expect you to give up your criticism of the Kennedys until you are able to do so of your own free will.

Mr. Arnoni is quite wrong in regard to the Kennedys. I sympathize with his need to hate and I understand the great loathing he must have for the German Catholic hierarchy and for the <sup>Senior</sup> Kennedys who tolerated this and who did not want to participate in stopping Hitler. There are many things I understand, and in particular I understand that Mr. Arnoni's comment "A DEAD BROTHER IS NO BROTHER" was more of a self-revelatory footnote to his own nature. I do agree that the dead JFK is no brother to Arnoni, for even in death Mr. Arnoni hates this brother.

Please write to Penn. I told him you would. I realize that your love for Mr. Arnoni must take precedence over your feelings for me, Sylvia. I am so sorry. I have enjoyed our relationship a great deal.
