Thank you very much for your letter of the 1st of November and especially for the advance on royalties. I am forwarding to Gary Owens the contract for signature, the check payable to him, and the personal questionnaire. I have asked him to return the contract and the questionnaire to you.

I would like to provide you with my corrected copy of the SUBJECT INDEX TO THE WARREN REPORT AND THE HEARINGS AND EXHIBITS, in which I have pasted the corrections and/or additions directly over the printed text. However, I should not like to entrust this copy to the mails, since it is the only such copy in existence. I will therefore arrange to have it hand-delivered to you.

I agree that we should devise a title which will encompass both indexes. My suggestion is MASTER INDEX TO THE INVESTIGATIONS OF THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, followed by a sub-title indicating that the master index covers the work of the House Select Committee on Assassinations (pertaining to the Kennedy assassination) and of the Warren Commission. (The House Select Committee also investigated the assassination of Martin Luther King but that part of its work is not included in the master index.)

In due course, I will prepare an "Explanatory Note" and also a Foreword to serve as an introduction to the contents.

I am happy to have this opportunity of working with Scarecrow Press again and with you personally.
