Here's my index to vol. I. I'm also sending copies to Paul Hoch for distribution to others.

In doing it up, I began to give some thought to the organization of the master index. For this reason, I tried to pull some of the material together under a few broad headings. Comparing this one to the index of vol. VII, for example, I listed "Anterior Neck Wound" under "Wounds: Kennedy; Anterior Neck Wound" rather than separately. I also made large groupings under such headings as "Bullets" and "Photographic Evidence." I'd be grateful for any comments.

I also listed the various exhibits under their subject headings on the theory that someone who wants to find, say, a copy of the autopsy descriptive sheet can do so under that heading. You'll also notice that I follow the various references of HSCA members and staff with the name of the person giving testimony, though I'm not sure how helpful it might be.

I think now that I might have included a heading under "Warren Commission: Critics of," given a number of references throughout. Among them, Sturdivan's reply on p. 420 to the question of whether new tests should be done to duplicate CE399 and the wounds -- "I can't answer from a viewpoint of somebody who is trying to quiet the critics"-- shouldn't be buried.

I'll move ahead on vol. III unless you've already started it or unless you'd like to do it.

To date, I have your indexes to the following: The Report, Vols. 7, 10, and 12 as well as your list & description of the exhibits. Could you send copies of those I'm missing?
