Dear Gary,

I am enclosing the Table of Contents for Section 2. Subject Index. It is eighteen pages long, but I think it is indispensable. Any typographical errors have been corrected in the original copy that will go to Scarecrow. I made one series of arbitrary omissions, in order to save a few pages--that is, I did not include the names of individual newspapers and periodicals. I hope that is okay with you. When you have a chance (no hurry) please send me a xerox copy of the enclosed Table of Contents together with a copy of the Subject Index itself, which I will need after I send the copy I have to Scarecrow and before the book is published.

I just received the Introduction which Russ Stetler kindly wrote. I am not entirely happy with it and within the next few days I will re-write it so as to eliminate the first page and a half, with consequential changes in the remaining text. I will then send it to Paul, to see if the revision is okay with Russ, and will ask Paul to send you a copy.

Incidentally, under "Acknowledgments", I think we should add a word of appreciation to Paul Hoch and Jeff Goldberg for their help. If you agree, I will take a sentence on to the text you prepared.

I will also do a Table of Contents for the book as a whole, which should not take more than one page.

That seems to be all for the moment. Again, my congratulations on your masterful Subject Index.
