Dear Paul,

My grateful thanks for your letter of the 14th and the copies of the indexes which were enclosed. I think I must owe you money, at least for postage. Please let me know how much, if you have kept records, and I will send you a check.

The indexing of the individual volumes is now complete. I am now compiling a "key to names" and have 15 columns of names under "organized crime" alone, and almost as many under "associates of Jack Ruby". In the course of doing this compilation, I was able to assemble a list of witnesses --in public hearings, in executive session, in top secret closed hearings (there were two, and perhaps more that we do not know about), and by deposition. The compilation also yielded a list of the experts and panel members, and a list of the staff members. These will be broken down according to field of expertise, in the case of the experts, and for the staff I will separate the counsel, investigators, researchers, and "ether".

About Harold's request to send the indexes to his contact at the Justice Department, yes, sure, it is okay.
