
The letterhead of this organization has no validity at this present date, since the Theatre Arts Foundation has been defunct since May 1966.

I have informed Mr. Freed that he had no right to use this letterhead for any personal interests of his own. He has indicated to me that he will therefore follow up his original letter to all the addressees with a statement correcting the implication that any of the persons listed on this letterhead are sponsors of his statements.

Whether he does so or not, I would like you and your organization to know that I am herewith disclaiming any connection with his project.
