I would have hoped that one of them, at least, had enough integrity and conscience to speak out, even at this late date.

Although the situation is discouraging, the more so because some of the foremost critics sometimes exhibit poor judgment (or worse), those of us who are aware and concerned will have to continue exerting our efforts for as long as there is any small hope.
