Dear Mrs. Lais,

Your idea of a nationwide effort is, in principle, commendable. I have some doubt whether it is practical, frankly, because I fear that time may have run out. In any case, if you do initiate a campaign, I would suggest that it should have the objective of reopening the whole case of the assassination of President Kennedy, on the basis of the totality of the critical work on the Warren Report, rather than a movement directed to such specifics as you itemize in your letter of the 6th.

There are already a number of groups actively circulating and collecting signatures on petitions, on both coasts. Perhaps you might join your efforts with such a group instead of starting from scratch. The New York-based group, which I regard as more responsible and objective than some of the others, is the Kennedy Assassination Inquiry Committee, Post Office Box 2691, New York City 10001, and the Chairman is Trent Gough, should you wish to contact him.
