Dear Miss Meagher,

The truths of your marvelous book, Accessories after the Fact, need to be put in some simple form with an exciting title, so that even the occasional plain man-in-the-street reader will read and talk about it. It looks like our leaders need leading (through public opinion) as far as the truth ever getting known and history correctly written about Kennedy's murder is concerned.

I have an idea how maybe this could be done. It would be based on how trials are reported in the newspapers—about 50% actual testimony and 50% summarizing testimony. Most newspaper readers read these trials, though many never read regular books.

If you could create in this newspaper account form a book that would portray how Oswald ~~is~~ could actually have been tried, with the prosecution skillfully presenting the case of the "Warren Report," and the defense cross-examining each witness to elicit their testimony now

buried in the 26 Volumes and elsewhere -  
all in accordance with accepted rules  
of evidence. And then the defense could  
call scores of eyewitnesses whose  
testimony Warren did not want to  
reach his ears.

Then everyone <sup>could</sup> ~~can~~ see how the attempt  
was made to defraud us and our  
posterity of the truth through the efforts  
of the Chief Justice of our Supreme Court.

and if your book should cause people  
to wonder how much respect this man  
has shown for our Constitution during  
the last 15 years, it would, to an

the weaknesses occurring in every  
single major "finding" and send it  
to all presidential candidates and  
Congressional leaders.

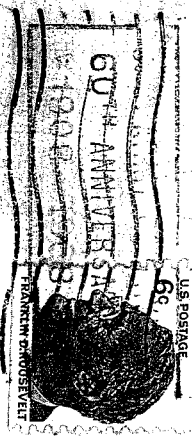
