Dear Paris,

The Subject Index has been out of print since March 1967 and I have found it absolutely impossible to obtain an extra copy for myself or for the individuals who contact me from time to time urgently seeking one. However, I do have a xerox copy which was made from microfilm which one of these individuals was good enough to make available (from the public library copy of the Subject Index). I use the xerox copy to make the index available on loan (for re-xeroxing) on request. I ask borrowers to return the xerox copy within two to three weeks, so that it will be available for the next loan.

Luckily, the xerox of the index is on hand now and I will therefore leave it with my doorman, in an envelope indicating that it will be picked up by you. I hope this will be helpful to you, in lieu of a bound copy. Ironically, I had sent one of my two personal copies of the index to Garrison, early in 1967, before the nature of his activities and his character became clear to me; and I guess I'll never get that copy back.
