Re: Photograph on page 88 of the Curry book, caption no. 3

The explanation of that huge bullet fragment that we have all been puzzling about ("A metal fragment from the arm of Governor Connally") is simple: Curry has mislabeled this and other objects in the photo.

Caption 3 should read "button from Tippit's uniform" and caption 5 ("Textile fibers found on...the recovered rifle") should read "bullet fragment taken from the body of John Connally at Parkland Hospital."

See testimony of Lt. Day in 4H 274-275 and CE 738, from which the miscaptioning becomes clear. I guess we all failed to give Curry due credit for his glorious ignorance and phenomenal ineptitude. Wild goose, anyone?
