Dear Mr. Levine,

The Subject Index has been out of print for more than two years now but the enclosed "Notice" will indicate how a xerox copy can be obtained. I do not think that any professional discount will be allowed, since I was refused an author's copy and had to purchase one. Moreover, I have the impression that orders are not filled very promptly and would suggest that if you do order a copy you should emphasize that you need it very urgently.

You may already know that after the <u>Subject Index</u> was completed, I wrote a comprehensive analysis and critique of the Warren Report which was published in the fall of 1967 by the Bobbs-Merrill Company of New York and Indianapolis. This book, <u>Accessories After the Fact: The Warren Commission</u>, the <u>Authorities and the Report</u>, is available in many public libraries. I mention it because it is, in a sense, a fleshed-out narrative corresponding to a large extent with the <u>Subject Index</u>.

I do, of course, know your name, generally and in the context of the Hearings of the Warpen Commission. I assume from your inquiry about the Index that you are continuing or contemplating work on the case. Certainly, I hope so, as every available brain and pair of hands is needed and can make a contribution to the clucidation of the real facts. I suspect that we have quite different views in many respects but that we probably agree on one point—the unreliability and indeed the fraudulence of the Warren Report.

I would be interested to know more about your work on the case and to be of assistance, if I could.
