Dear Mark Houpt,

I receive many letters like yours of 4 October 1969 and unfortunately I simply do not have the time to reply in great detail.

As to your first question: The route from the Book Depository to the rooming house is known, while the route from the rooming house supposedly to the Tippit scene is merely conjectured by the Warren Commission. These questions are discussed in detail in the Warren Report, Chapter IV, and in my own book, Chapters 3 and 13.

Your second question: As above.

Your third and fourth questions: I have no information on these matters.

Your fifth question: I suggest that you consult any standard work on criminal investigation. See also Warren Report, Appendix X, and my book, page 171.

Your sixth question: I do not know the address for Dr. Helpern, and I am not at liberty to disclose the address for Dr. Wecht.

Your seventh question: You seem to have read most of the central critical works and I cannot think of anything to suggest. There are a number of bibliographies on the subject which you might consult, if your library has them. Above all, you should read for yourself the 26 volumes of Hearings and Exhibits of the Warren Commission.
