This is because it is caused by the effect of the power transformer (which is just the other side of the thin wooden dividing wall, the way things are set up now)
on the magnets of the pickup head：the closer to the wall the pickup is，the more hum it＂picks up＂（by induction．）This could be eliminated by some kind（I＇m not sure jut what）of grounding，or shield－ ing－don＇t feel inclined to experiment with it，tonight maybe I will，sometime．
