The Defendant is more ill than she has any right to be; 23 This illness damages the Plaintiffs in their absolute right 5. 24 to have the Defendant in good working order. 25 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant 26 start feeling better at her earliest opportunity, and IT IS FURTHER 27 ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiffs be awarded from Def-28 endant a reasonable attorneys' fee, the amount to be set by Burke 29 Marshall and placed with the autopsy material in the National 30 Archives or any other convenient memory hole, to earn interest at 31 the rate of 22% (twenty-two percent) from the date of judgment, 32 FINDINGS OF FACT AND DECREE - 1
