Dear Ms. Meagher,

I have just finished reading a series of books on the assassination of Pres. Kennedy of which your book Accessories After The Fact: was the ^{most} convincing and remarkable for its scholarship. And for that reason I am addressing this letter to you. I am just a troubled citizen with questions and I do not know who to ask. I was very disturbed by the allegation of Cuban rightist involvement in the conspiracy theory in lieu of the Watergate affair and their close working relationship with President Nixon. Plus under the conspiracy theory is the possibility of General Walker's name used as front to show Oswald had been involved with a previous assassination. Then Richard Nixon's name strangely appears as another ~~proof~~ ^{proof}, later proved impossible, of Oswald's assassination tendencies. Why is Nixon's name used? And how much use has he made of the Cuban right to keep the left in line? And has any more substantial *facts* arisen of Cuban involvement in the assassination. Ruby claims Johnson was involved, has anybody checked this out? Johnson said in the new Atlantic Monthly article the C.I.A. murdered Kennedy to stop him from stopping a Murder Inc. they were running in the Caribbean. Is this being looked into? And finally I was puzzled as to why the White House plumber unit had broken into Bremer's apartment ^{the night} after he shot Wallace? Was this been brought out in connection with the Cuban rightist involvement in our national security?

If you know of any groups that might be investigating the above I would appreciate if you could send me their names and addresses. I would like to offer any help I could as a very concerned person as to who is running our country. My plans

are now to take three months to bicycle from San Francisco east and to try farming in West Virginia but I would like to do what little I could if anything to help a responsible investigation. I will give you my Mother's address ¹⁷⁰¹~~1701~~ Philadelphia to which I hope you may find the time to answer some of my questions. Your book has alerted me to a possible if not already existing erosion of the freedom I so dearly cherish and I fear our leaders may be selling away for wealth, security, and power. I thank you for sounding the alert and would appreciate any information you may find time to share.
