I am certainly very grateful for the information you sent me about the out-of-print dealer. I will notify several persons who have recently inquired how they could obtain copies of Accessories.

I am equally grateful for your generous words about the book itself.

The allegations made by Penn Jones and/or Richard Sprague are familiar to me. To be quite frank, I discount most of them. For example, the "Betty Macdonald" who was present at the February 1963 party given by Everett Glover is not the same woman who hanged herself in the Dallas jail but an Elizabeth Macdonald, who worked for the same chemical company as Glover or one of his guests—I forget which. The Warren Commission's index (either in the summary volume or in Volume XV—again, I forget which) is misleading, as it treats the two women as one. But any serious researcher would have discovered that before making wild charges.

I would appreciate a copy of the newspaper account of Jimmy Earl Burt and his claim that Oswald did not kill Tippit. That is new to me.
