Dear Mr. Tatro,

Thank you for your letter of the 16th and the clipping from the National Enquirer of May 31, 1970.

You have requested my comments on two questions. The first is an allegation by Penn Jones and the Marchisons, Nixon and J. Edgar Hoover. I have no independent information on that, one way or another, but suppose it is true? What of it? Would such a party or meeting necessarily link any or all of the participants to the assassination?

The second question refers to alleged evidence linking Ruby with Nixon and HUAC in 1947. Again, I can neither confirm nor deny the allegation, and if it was true, I do not see any necessary connection with the Dallas case.

I have not seen the Jack Anderson column defending Frank Sturgis. I do readily agree with your analogy of "misguided patriotism" to that of Hitler. I am not familiar with any photograph of a man on Dealey Plaza who resembles Sturgis.

I am sorry that my comments are not more positive, but that is the way I see things.
