Today I was reading the November 10, 1975 PEOPLE magazine and I saw the write up on your JFK "library." Perhaps you can help me.

In August 1972 I read an article published in one of the weekly tabloid "scandal sheet" newspapers. It had several pages on reports that JFK lived for several years after his "assassination." The CIA apparently figured he would die from the severe head wounds, but medically his life was sustained. It went on to say how his body was "kept alive" in Dallas and later Greece.

I have written to many of the tabloids requesting information on the article; all of them denied even any knowledge of such a story. I thought this was rather strange.

If you can get me a copy of this story from your files, I would be very appreciative. If you have never heard of it perhaps it would be worth looking into.
