Do we know where the bullet (of the three) that missed JFK struck? Which side of the car? Or where?


Have I read somewhere that LO and another man were firing side by side -- one shooting twice, one once -- accounting for the three casings? Or were the casings identical, and known to be from same gun?

Do you happen to remember where Mr. Paine was at the time of the JFK murder? He does show up back at the house later that day? Have the Paines dropped out of sight entirely?

Do you know where in W.C. Report there is extensive recapitulation of the Nov. 21 conversations at Paine house?

Why do you think LO maintained he was merely a patsy, that he shot no one?
