Dear Mr. Nessen :

For my research into the death of President John Kennedy, I would greatly appreciate a copy of the transcript of News Conference #1327-C dated November 22, 1963. This should be the transcript of a medical briefing for reporters by Drs. Malcolm Perry and Kemp Clark of Parkland Hospital in Dallas. I would also like to know the following :

(1) Who made the recording from which this transcript was made, where is that recording now, and what was its chain of possession from November 22, 1963 to the present?

(2) When was the transcript made and by whom?

(3) What was the title of Mr. Wayne Hawks on that day, and is there any way your office knows of that I might be able to reach him now?

(4) Since the incumbent President of the United States was a member of the Warren Commission which investigated the assassination in 1964, I would like to know whether he as an individual or the Warren Commission in general knew of the existence of this transcript.

(5) Can your office shed any light on why this transcript has been "lost" these many years?

I am grateful for any assistance you may be able to offer.
