Dear Karen,

Thank you for your very, very nice letter and for your generous comments on my work. The knowledge that my books are being used for study and research is extremely gratifying to me.

I am also very grateful for your offer of help and perhaps I will avail myself of it. While I am not doing any active work on the case any more, I am highly interested in major newspaper and magazine stories on the assassination. I will be away from the beaten track on two occasions during the next year, when I will not have ready access to the news media. First, during July and the first half of August this year; and, second, if my present plans work out, I will be on a trip around the world from mid-January to mid-April 1977.

Would you be willing to collect any newspaper and magazine stories on the JFK assassination (and any major stories on the RFK and Martin Luther King cases) and transmit them to me? I would, of course, pay the costs of the newspapers and magazine and also the postage. If that is an agreeable arrangement for you, let me know and I will send further details. If it is not possible, please do not hesitate to say so and I will not be in the least offended.

On the subject of UFOs: I would be very interested to have a description of your close encounter in 1965 and if you have no objection I would pass it on to an active researcher whom I know, for his information and possible computerization (with or without names of the witnesses).
