Dear Friend:

After 13 years, there finally exists the possibility of an honest and thorough investigation into the assassination of J.F.Kennedy.In September '76, the U.S. House of Representatives established a Select Committee to study the murders of J.F.K. and Martin Luther King. The A.I.B is now opening an office in Washington to represent the public interest in this investigation.

Over the years, the Federal Government and much of the National Media have made apparent their unwillingness to solve the crime of Dallas. It is increasingly clear that the truth behind this crime and other political murders will only come out through the determined efforts of the American people.

However, the fledging investigation is running into difficulty in Congress. We appeal for your help in our efforts to make this a successful investigation.

The A.I.B. is organizing a unique public interest office in Washington to:

- \* monitor and review the work of the Committee
- \* provide responsible scholars and researchers access to the Committee's staff.
- \* and keep the American people informed of the progress of the Investigation.

Never before has an offical inquiry into a major political murder been scrutinized by the public as it unfolds.

But Americans shouldn't sit back and assume the answers will be forthcoming. Previous investigations have shown that the coverup is tenacious, and will not become unglued without public demand. Already there is concerted opposition in the House to the Committee. We urge all concerned citizens to act now before this crucial opportunity passes!
