Dear Ms. Meagher,

I am an independent researcher into the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. Until recently it has just entailed the reading of many books on the subject (including your own). Quite by accident however, I think I came across something that if true could put a whole new light on the subject. I am writing to you because I value your integrity and knowledge on the topic and also due to the fact that I have no desire to over react and accidentally make the present investigation a farce.

This is what I've found:

On either Sept 24 or Oct 1 1963, (my information is still unclear on this) Oswald was supposedly in Mexico City trying to attain a passport to go to Cuba and from there to the Soviet Union. This was to further Oswald's link to Cuba and the USSR.

At the Cuban + the Soviet Embassy under normal procedures, photographs were taken of all people who entered and left ~~both~~ both buildings. As a result there are photographs of a person whom the CIA identified as Oswald. I believe this is Warren Commission exhibit #237. Obviously in looking at the picture the man is definitely not Oswald and for the most part is still unidentified.

The reason I say "for the most part" is because Hugh C McDonald in his book Appointment in Dallas states that he tracked down this man (called Saul in ~~the~~ the book.) He further states that this is the man whom called Kennedy. If this is true or not, it does not really affect what I think I've found. However, there are several more photographs of "Saul" in the book.

In another book Betrayal by Robert D Morrow, the author, claims to have bought 4 Mannlicher Carcano rifles. Morrow, an ex-CIA agent in his book states that it was another CIA agent who was in Mexico City at that time.

In a chance comparison of the Commission exhibit and the picture of Robert Morrow on the back of the paperback edition of the book Betrayal I found that the men in the two pictures were remarkably compatible and that they ^{might be} the ~~same~~ same person. I do not need to go into the implications of this at the present time.

I realize that you are a busy woman. Under normal circumstances, I would not write to someone I don't know and ask advice. 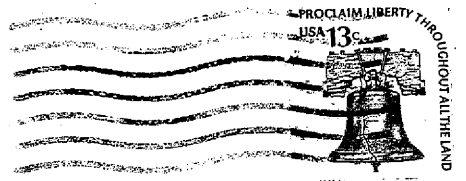
